

# Workforce Innovation Opportunity Act (WIOA) Eligibility

## Are you....

1. Currently on unemployment, or have received UI benefits in last 5 years
2. A person who has been laid off in last 5 years through no fault of your own (must be able to document this)
3. A public assistance recipient (Food Stamps, TANF, income-based Medicaid)
4. Basic skills deficient (Below 9<sup>th</sup> grade TABE, ESL if you do not understand English fluently)
5. Meeting the federal low income guidelines \*\*\*See table below.
6. Meeting any of the below criteria:
  - a. A Displaced Homemaker
  - b. An eligible Migrant and Seasonal Farm Workers
  - c. A person with misdemeanors or felonies on your background
  - d. A Native American, Alaska Natives, or Native Hawaiians
  - e. An individuals with disabilities
  - f. An Individuals who faces substantial cultural barriers
  - g. A long-term unemployed individual (27 or more *consecutive* weeks)
  - h. Over age 55
  - i. A single parent (including single pregnant women)
  - j. A person that does not have HS Diploma or GED

If you answered “YES” to ***at least 1 of these questions***,  
WIOA may be able to help you with tuition!
